# Installation Instructions










Monogram™ Surface Row Indicator can be mounted almost anywhere row indication or information is needed. The surface mount design allows for floor installation in carpeted areas or on the face of step risers. It also mounts to standard J-Box for wall applications.


## Mounting applications:

- 1. Floor
- 2. Step RIser
- 3. Wall

# **Preparation for Surface Installation:**

**Step 1:** The Monogram<sup>™</sup> Row Indicator should be mounted on the floor near a wireway to allow connection to power. It may be mounted with the short edge or the long edge along the wireway, as shown.






**Step 2:** Determine location and orientation for Monogram™ unit. Cut a rectangular hole in the carpet to match the size of the Monogram™ base, as shown. The hole should be at least ½″ away from the wireway to leave room for the Cover Plate.

**Step 3:** Remove wireway cover.

**Step 4:** Drill hole in side of wireway extrusion to accomodate wire from Monogram  $^{\text{m}}$  unit.






# Installation Instructions (Continued)

#### **Install Base**

**Step 1:** Pre-position the base to use as a template to mark the location for two pilot holes.


**Step 2:** Drill pilot holes to accomodate appropriate screws for mounting material, ie: wood screws for wood, cement screws for cement (2 cement screws included).

**Step 3:** Position base on floor with the wire output notch facing the wireway (See note on Page 3). Run wire under carpet to the previously drilled hole in wireway. Feed wires through hole and attach base with two screws, as shown.




#### **Install Lens Assembly**

**Step 1:** Run wires through Notch in Monogram™ Base and route under carpet through the hole previously drilled in wireway. **Step 2:** Position Lens Assembly in center of Base, as shown.



#### **Connect to Power**

**Step 1:** Wireway cover should be removed to allow access to wiring. **Step 2:** Using the Butt Connectors provided, connect the white positive wire from the Monogram<sup>™</sup> Unit to the positive wire from the power supply. Connect the black negative wire from the Monogram<sup>™</sup> unit to the negative wire from the power supply, as shown. **Step 3:** Replace wireway cover.






# Installation Instructions (Continued)

**Step 3:** Standard Row Indicator Orientation is with the wire originating from the top of the Lens. However, for proper orientation, there are installations that require the wire to emerge from the bottom of the fixture. For this application, route the wire around the lens inside the Base, as shown, following the path indicated to avoid any excessive bending of the wire. Be sure to position the notch on the proper side in order to allow the correct wire path.


**Note:** Determine the proper notch position before attaching Base to mounting surface.



# Install Lens and Cover

**Step 1:** Place Cover Plate in position over the base unit, making sure the Indicator lens is positioned properly to fit through the opening.

**Step 2:** Secure with four Hex Screws using 2mm Hex Wrench (provided in kit).
